

NOTICE OF RACE

Skiff Festival Santa Barbara Yacht Club Santa Barbara, CA

May 17 & 18, 2008

1. RULES

This regatta will be governed by the 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of U.S. Sailing, the rules of the applicable one-design classes (except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions), this NOR, and the Sailing Instructions.

2. CLASSES

Classes invited to compete are: 29er, International 14, and any other one-design skiff fleet with at least three entries.

3. ENTRY

Entries will be taken at SBYC before the competitors' meeting Saturday morning. No entry fee will be required.

4. VENUE & SAILING AREA

Registration for all classes will take place at the Santa Barbara Yacht Club Fleet Room located on the lower deck of the club. All post-sailing activities will take place at the Santa Barbara Yacht Club. All classes will sail on a course approximately .5 miles south of Santa Barbara harbor.

5. SCHEDULE

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available on the website (www.sbyc.org/Racing.html) approximately one week prior to the event. Copies will also be available at registration.

7. BOAT STORAGE

Boats may be stored in the parking lot adjacent to the launch ramp during the event on trailers or on West Beach on dollies. No trailers are allowed on the beach, just dollies. Trailers and vehicles will be subject to normal parking fees, but if you can get in and out on 15 minutes you can park for free at one of the SBCC lots located northwest of the Harbor.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

Rule 44.2 is modified such that only one complete turn, including a tack and a gybe, shall be required. For the 18 footers only, there shall be no penalty for touching a mark.

9. SCORING

The low-point scoring system of Appendix A will apply. However, six races must be completed before a discard may be applied. One race must be completed to constitute a series.

10. PRIZES

Take home trophies will be awarded to the top finishers in each class on Sunday, May 20th.
