

NOTICE OF RACE

Semana Nautica Regatta

SBYC / SBSSA

Santa Barbara, CA

June 28 – 29, 2008

1. HOST AND ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The regatta is hosted and organized by the Santa Barbara Yacht Club and the Santa Barbara Sea Shell Association.

2. RULES

This regatta will be governed by the 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of U.S. Sailing, the rules of the applicable one-design classes (except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions), this NOR, and by the Sailing Instructions.

3. CLASSES

Classes invited to compete are **U.S. Sabots, Seashells, CFJ's, Lasers, Laser Radials**, and any other one-design fleet with at least five entries. Saturday's races will be scored as the U.S. Sabots High Point Regatta in Santa Barbara (Saturday's and Sunday's races will be scored as the Semana Nautica Regatta).

4. ENTRY

Competitors may enter by filling out and returning a completed entry form and paying applicable fees. Entry forms may be found on the SBYC Racing webpage (www.sbyc.org/Racing.html) or at the registration desk.

5. VENUE & SAILING AREA

Registration for all classes will take place at the Santa Barbara harbor launch ramp at the south-eastern end of Santa Barbara harbor. All post-sailing activities will take place at the Santa Barbara Yacht Club. There will be three sailing areas. Seashells and Sabot C's will sail inside Santa Barbara harbor off Seashell Beach. Sabot A's and B's will sail on a course off the end of Stearns Wharf. All double-handed boats and Lasers will sail on a course approximately .5 miles south of Santa Barbara harbor.

7. LUNCH

Lunch will be provided at no cost to Sabot C and Sea Shell sailors by the SB Sea Shell Assn.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available on the website (www.sbyc.org/Racing.html). Copies will also be available at registration.

9. BOAT STORAGE

Boats may be stored in the launch ramp parking lot in designated areas during the event.

10. SCORING

The low-point scoring system of Appendix A will apply, except that each boat's score shall be the total of her finishing places. No races will be discarded. High Point scoring shall be subject to the series NOR.

11. PRIZES

Take home trophies will be awarded to the top finishers in each class on Sunday.
