Race Entry Agreement

In consideration of acceptance of my entry by Santa Barbara Yacht Club ("SBYC"), I acknowledge and agree as follows:

1. I own or have chartered the boat entered and I am a member of a yacht club or sailing association that belongs to USSA. My boat will be equipped to conform with USCG, USSA and Class/Fleet safety requirements.
2. I am personally responsible for the operation of my boat and will comply with the rules of the ISAF as adopted by the USSA, and use of the marina, including CA Harbors and Navigation Code.
3. SBYC is not my insurer. I will maintain sufficient insurance to protect from all risks arising from this Agreement.
4. **ASSUMPTION OF RISK:** THERE ARE RISKS INHERENT IN THE SPORT OF YACHT RACING, AND I FREELY ASSUME ALL RISKS, INCLUDING PERSONAL INJURY OR DEATH TO MYSELF AND MY CREW, LOSS OR DAMAGE TO MY YACHT AND ITS EQUIPMENT, AS WELL AS UNFORESEEN RISKS.
5. **WAIVER, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION.** TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, I WAIVE ALL CLAIMS, FOREVER RELEASE AND AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS SBYC, ITS AFFILIATES, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS, COMMITTEE PERSONS AND RACE OFFICIALS ACTING IN THEIR OFFICIAL CAPACITIES, FROM ANY DAMAGE, LIABILITY, LOSS, COST OR EXPENSE INCLUDING ATTORNEY FEES, ARISING FROM MY AND MY CREW'S PARTICIPATION IN THE RACE, INCLUDING SBYC'S ACTIVE OR PASSIVE REGULAR NEGLIGENCE, BUT NOT SBYC'S WILLFUL MISCONDUCT OR GROSS NEGLIGENCE.

NOTICE OF RACE

JULY 18 & 19, 2009

1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the I.S.C.Y.R.A., the rules of the International Star Class (STCR) and this Notice of Race (except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions) and the Sailing Instructions.

2. Eligibility and Entry

Boats eligible in accordance with the rules of the International Star Class may be entered by registering with Santa Barbara Yacht Club prior to 1000 hours, Saturday, July 18th, 2009 using the attached entry form accompanied by a fee of \$50.00.

3. Schedule of Events

Registration:

Friday, July 17, 2007 1700-1900 hours

Saturday, July 18, 2009 0830-1000 hours

Competitor's Briefing:

Saturday, July 18, 2009 1000 hours

Racing:

Race Day and Date Time of Warning Signal

1 Saturday, July 18, 2009 1155 hours

2 Saturday, July 18, 2009 as soon as practical after Race 1

3 Saturday, July 18, 2009 as soon as practical after Race 2

4 Sunday, July 19, 2009 1155 hours

5 Sunday, July 19, 2009 as soon as practical after Race 4

No race shall start after 1530 hours on Sunday, July 20, 2008.

Social:

Friday, July 17, 2009 1700-1900 hours Complimentary hors d'oeuvre and no host bar on the upper deck.

Friday, July 17, 2009 1800-2100 hours No host dinner available in the SBYC dining room (fine dining – reservation required).

Saturday, July 18, 2009 Après Sailing Complimentary beer, wine and hors d'oeuvre on the upper deck.

Sunday, July 19, 2009 Après Sailing Awards presentation, complimentary beer, wine and pasta bar in the SBYC Clubhouse.

4. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions in draft version will be available at www.sbyc.org/Racing.html. The final version of the Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

5. Racing Area

The racing area will be southwest of the entrance to the Santa Barbara Harbor.

6. Courses to be Sailed

The course(s) to be sailed will be windward-leeward, and variations thereof, as described in the Sailing Instructions.

7. Mooring

Boats may be hauled daily. Dock space will be available for those who prefer to remain afloat and raft.

8. Scoring

Scoring will be as described in the RRS, Appendix A, except that all races shall count toward each yacht's score. One race shall constitute a series.

9. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to the top boats overall (skippers & crew) and the first place boat (skipper & crew) with a hull number under 7000. The winning skipper and crew will have their names engraved on the Santa Barbara Yacht Club's Sir Thomas Lipton Perpetual Trophy to remain on display at the Santa Barbara Yacht Club.
