

## Notice of Race



### FIESTA CUP

*Hosted by Santa Barbara Yacht Club*

*July 25 & 26, 2009*

#### 1. Rules

This regatta will be governed by the “rules” as defined in the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing, the rules of each participating one design class and this NOR except as they are modified by the Sailing Instructions.

#### 2. Advertising

Advertising is limited as defined in the class rules of each fleet.

#### 3. Eligibility and Entry

The regatta is open to all members in good standing of the applicable one design classes and of a US Sailing member club.

#### 4. Fees

Entry Fees will be as follows for the participating classes:

Farr 40: \$125                  J/105: \$100                  Melges 24: \$75

Entries received after Friday July 24th shall be subject to a \$25 late fee.

#### 6. Measurement and Weigh-in

Each boat must provide a copy of its current measurement certificate. J/105s shall provide a copy of their current crew declaration form. Previously un-weighed crew shall complete weigh-in before 0945 on Saturday July 25, 2009.

#### 7. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available online at [www.sbyc.org/racing](http://www.sbyc.org/racing) and at registration.

**8. Venue**

The venue shall be the Santa Barbara Channel within 2 miles of SBYC.

**9. Courses**

A course chart will be attached to the Sailing Instructions.

**10. Penalty System**

Rule 44.2 is modified such that a boat that has broken a Rule of Part 2 may take a penalty of one turn (including one tack and one gybe) provided that the incident occurred beyond 2 boat lengths from the nearest mark.

**11. Scoring**

The low-point scoring system of Appendix A will apply except that all races will be counted.

**12. Berthing**

Slips can be arranged by contacting the Santa Barbara Harbor Patrol on Channel 16 or 12 upon arrival. Slip reservations are not taken. Each boat is responsible for her slip fees (at \$0.90 per foot per night). Slips are not available from SBYC.

**13. Radio Communication**

Each boat shall monitor VHF Channel 68 for instructions from the Race Committee.

**14. Prizes**

Take home trophies will be awarded to the top finishers in each class.

**15. Other Events**

SBYC invites participating teams to compete in the Santa Barbara to King Harbor race on July 31 & August 1, 2009. For more information please contact SBYC. Boats staying for the week between these regattas should notify the Harbor Patrol upon arrival.

**16. Disclaimer of Liability**

Participants in this event compete entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. Each boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with adequate limits for this event, or the equivalent.
