# NOTICE OF RACE

SANTA BARBARA YACHT CLUB

SIR THOMAS LIPTON TROPHY

August 13 & 14, 2011

## 1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the I.S.C.Y.R.A., the rules of the International Star Class (STCR) and this Notice of Race (except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions) and the Sailing Instructions.

## 2. Eligibility and Entry

Boats eligible in accordance with the rules of the International Star Class may be entered by registering with Santa Barbara Yacht Club prior to 1200 hours on Friday, August 12<sup>th</sup>, 2011 using the online entry provided by Regatta Network, accompanied by a fee of \$50.00. Visit: Late entries can also be made in person during registration.

## 3. Schedule of Events

### Registration:

### Racing:

Saturday First Warning: 1200 hours  
Sunday First Warning: 1200 hours  
No race shall start after 1530 hours on Sunday.

### Social:

Friday

1700-1900 hours: Complimentary hors d'oeuvre and no host bar on the upper deck.  
1800-2100 hours: No host dinner available in the SBYC dining room (fine dining – reservation required).

Saturday

Après Sailing: Complimentary beer, wine and hors d'oeuvre on the upper deck.

Sunday

Après Sailing: Awards presentation, complimentary beer, wine and pasta bar in the SBYC Clubhouse.

#### **4. Sailing Instructions**

Sailing Instructions will be available at [www.sbyc.org/Racing.html](http://www.sbyc.org/Racing.html) approximately one week before the event. Copies will be available at registration.

#### **5. Racing Area**

Racing will be held in Santa Barbara Channel, within 3 miles of the entrance to the Santa Barbara Harbor.

#### **6. Courses to be Sailed**

The course(s) to be sailed will be windward-leeward, and variations thereof, as described in the Sailing Instructions.

#### **7. Mooring**

Boats may be hauled daily and stored at SBYC. Dock space will be available for those who prefer to remain afloat and raft.

#### **8. Scoring**

Scoring will be as described in the RRS, Appendix A, except that all races shall count toward each yacht's score. One race shall constitute a series.

#### **9. Prizes**

Prizes will be awarded to the top boats overall (skippers & crew) and the first place boat (skipper & crew) with a hull number under 7000. The winning skipper and crew will have their names engraved on the Santa Barbara Yacht Club's Sir Thomas Lipton Perpetual Trophy to remain on display at the Santa Barbara Yacht Club.

#### **10. Disclaimer of Liability**

Participants in this event compete entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
