DEED OF GIFT

AMERIGO VESPUCCI

Model Ship

The AMERIGO VESPUCCI was built in the Navy Shipyard at Castellammare di Stabia and launched in 1931 as training a ship for the Italian Navy. She embarks with about 400 crew members and is fitted out to handle instruction courses for 150 naval cadets. The ship measures over 82 meters in length, 15 meters in width at the waterline, 61 meters from her keel to the top of her mast, and carries a sail plan of about 3000 square meters. The hull is completely made of steel plates bound by rivets. Auxiliary power is provided by two electric dynamos driven by two diesel powered generators. Maximum speed under power is approximately 12 knots.

The model measures 48" in length and 28" in height, and was completed after 18 months of work in 1984.

With this "Deed of Gift", I hereby donate the above described model ship, AMERIGO VESPUCCI, to the Santa Barbara Yacht Club under the following conditions:

1. The Santa Barbara Yacht Club shall retain exclusive possession of the model ship, and shall provide a proper case for its display and security on the club premises.
2. No alterations may be made to the model.
3. If the Santa Barbara Yacht Club, for any reason, decides it has no need for the model, it shall be returned to myself or my lawful heirs.
4. The Board of Directors of the Santa Barbara Yacht Club may designate the model as a sailing trophy by amending this condition from time to time without concurrence of the donor.
