DEED OF GIFT

I, Donald McFarland do hereby present to the SANTA BARBARA YACHT CLUB WOMEN (SBYCW) in perpetuity, the accompanying trophy, to hereinafter be known as the LEE MCFARLAND MEMORIAL TROPHY to be awarded to the member of the SBYCW who has made an outstanding contribution to the SBYCW and or to the SANTA BARBARA YACHT CLUB.

A committee of six women who represent a broad-based sampling of the Club, including at least two SBYCW Board Members, shall be appointed each year by the SBYCW's President to choose that year's nominee.

During his lifetime, Donald McFarland will supply a replica trophy each year to be awarded at the Trophy Dinner. After his death, the McFarland Estate will distribute \$10,000 to the SANTA BARBARA YACHT CLUB WOMEN to be used for funding future replica trophies.
