

(Replacement) Deed of Gift  
Shalhoob Women's Invitational Regatta Trophy

1. The Shalhoob Women's Invitational Regatta originated in 1984 as a collaboration of SBYC members Jane Watkins, Jerry Shalhoob and Robert Miller IV with the goal being to promote women's racing at the Santa Barbara Yacht Club.
2. The trophy is a plated flask in the shape of a bell which was donated by Robert Miller IV in 1984. It is on a wood base which will contain the names of the yearly winner of the event. The trophy shall be known as the Shalhoob Women's Invitational Trophy.
3. The Santa Barbara Yacht Club shall maintain the trophy and be responsible for its security and/or replacement. The trophy will be displayed during the year at Santa Barbara Yacht Club.
4. The intent of this trophy and the regatta bearing its name will be to provide an opportunity for the growth of women's racing in Santa Barbara; encourage women to participate in yacht racing, and to augment camaraderie amongst women sailors. To that end, skipper eligibility is open to female members of a yacht club, wives or family members of a yacht club, or she may be a sailor who is authorized by a SBYC member to be the driver/skipper.
5. The desired class of boat for this event shall be one design.
6. A minimum of one race shall be completed to determine the yearly winner of this trophy.
7. The Board of Directors of Santa Barbara Yacht Club may change any of the provisions of the Deed of Gift where they deem such change beneficial to the promotion of racing participation by women or to improve the competition for the trophy.
