

The Organizing Authority for the 2015 Semana Nautica Regatta will be:
The Santa Barbara Sea Shell Association (SBSSA) &
The Santa Barbara Yacht Club (SBYC), 130 Harbor Way, Santa Barbara, CA 93109

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 The US Sailing prescriptions to rules 60, 63.2, 63.4 will not apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Optimist, US Sabot, Laser, Laser Radial, Lido 14, RS Feva and any dinghy class with five or more entries.
- 2.2 Competitors may enter online or by filling out a completed online entry form. Link to online entry and entry forms may be found online at http://www.sbycracing.org/2015-semana-nautica.
- 2.3 Entry fee of \$10 per boat

3. SCHEDULE

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Sailing Instructions will be available on the website (www.sbycracing.org/2015-semana-nautica/) approximately one week prior to the regatta. Copies will also be available at registration.

5. VENUE

5.1 Registration for all classes will take place at the Santa Barbara harbor launch ramp at the east end of Santa Barbara harbor city parking lot as shown in 'Attachment A – Parking, Boat, Trailer, & Dolly Storage'. All post-sailing activities will take place at the Santa Barbara Yacht Club. There will be two sailing areas. Sabot C's and Optimist Green Fleet will sail inside Santa Barbara harbor off Seashell Beach. All other established classes will sail on a course within a half mile of the harbor entrance.

6. LUNCH

6.1 All competitors will need to provide their own lunch.

7. THE COURSES

7.1 The courses to be sailed will be a windward-leeward or triangle configuration.

8. SCORING

- 8.1 The low-point scoring system of Appendix A will apply.
- 8.2 One race must be completed to constitute a series.
- 8.3 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

9. BOAT STORAGE

9.1 Boats may be stored in the launch ramp parking lot in designated areas during the event as shown in 'Attachment A'.

10. PRIZES


10.1 Take home trophies for the Semana Nautica regatta will be awarded to the top finishers in each class on Saturday. All awards will take place at the post-racing BBQ at SBYC. All sailors and their families are welcome to attend.
