Attachment C – Tracking Transponder Instructions Santa Barbara to King Harbor Race 2022

Each boat will be required to be tracked during the 2022 Santa Barbara to King Harbor Race. A boat must either submit their Maritime Mobile Service Identity (MMSI) number from their AIS transponder through the entry process or install the 'Transponder' application on their phone and allow the application to run for the duration of the race. It is strongly recommended that boats do both options. Portable phone chargers will be provided to boats using their phones for tracking.

A configuration code will be sent to each boat once entries have closed. These configuration codes are necessary for those who will be tracking through their phone. They will also be available at checkin at the venue.

Race Tracking Setup - Transponder Application

Tracking during the race is performed by the free phone app "*Transponder*", available for **iPhone** and **Android**. The app can be found on the App Store or Google Play by searching for "*transponder*". To set it up for your boat just enter the configuration code that will be provided by the organizing authority to all competitors once entries close. 







