Amendments to the Sailing Instructions

RULES 1.8 is deleted and replaced with:

1.8 Appendix V, Alternative Penalties, Rule V1 – Penalties at the time of the incident will apply.

RULE 1.9 is added:

1.9 Appendix T, Arbitration, Rule T1, T2, T3, and T4 will apply.

Rule 19, PENALTY SYSTEM is deleted and replaced with:

- 19.1 Appendix V, Rule V1 will apply: The first two sentences of rule 44.1 are changed to: 'A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 or rule 31 in an incident while racing. However, when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 while in the zone around a mark other than a starting mark, her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty.'
- 19.2 Appendix T, Rule T1 – Post Race Penalties will apply:
 - Provided that rule 44.1(b) does not apply, a boat that may have broken one or more rules of (a) Part 2 or rule 31 in an incident may take a Post-Race Penalty at any time after the race until the beginning of a protest hearing involving the incident.
 - A Post-Race Penalty is a 30% Scoring Penalty calculated as stated in rule 44.3(c). However, rule (b) 44.1(a) applies.
 - A boat take a Post-Race Penalty by delivering to the arbitrator or a member of the protest (c) committee a written statement that she accepts the penalty and that identifies the race number and where and when the incident occurred.

Rule 20, PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS, is deleted and replaced with:

- 20.1 Protest forms are available at the front desk of SBYC. Protests and requests for redress or reopening shall be delivered to the front desk or Race Committee within the appropriate time limit.
- The protest time limit is within one hour of the protesting boat's finish time. 20.2
- 20.3 Appendix T – Arbitration, Rules T1, T2, T3, and T4 will apply.
- 20.4 Protest times and locations will be posted on the official notice board no later than 30 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses.
- 20.5 On the last scheduled day of racing a request for reopening a hearing shall be delivered
 - (a) within the protest time limit if the requesting party was informed of the decision on the previous day;
 - (b) no later than 30 minutes after the requesting party was informed of the decision on that day. This changes rule 66.
- 20.6 On the last scheduled day of racing a request for redress based on a protest committee decision shall be delivered no later than 30 minutes after the decision was posted. This changes rule 62.2.
