



# AMENDMENTS TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS & NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority for the 2025 PHRF SoCal Regional Championship will be:  
The Santa Barbara Yacht Club (SBYC), 130 Harbor Way, Santa Barbara, CA 93109

The notation [NP] in a *rule* means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that *rule*. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

The notation [DP] in a *rule* means that the penalty for a breach of a *rule* may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1. **Course 11 and Course 12 are added to 'Attachment E – RLC Course Chart':**
  - a. Course 11 = Start – D(p) – T1(p) – H(p) – X(s) – E(p) – Finish (distance = 5.01 nm)
  - b. Course 12 = Start – D(p) – T1(p) – H(p) – X(s) – T2(p) – E(p) – Finish (distance = 6.46 nm)
2. **The description of 'B' for 'Attachment E – RLC Course Chart' is added:**
  - a. Mark 'B' is a red and white government Bell Buoy.
3. **The following PHRF of Souther California perpetual trophies will be awarded:**
  - a. RLC A – Overall will be awarded to the A fleet boat with the lowest combined corrected time for all RLC races.
  - b. RLC B - Overall will be awarded to the B fleet boat with the lowest combined corrected time for all RLC races.
  - c. A Overall – This trophy will be awarded to the A fleet boat that won the PHRF SoCal Championship Regatta. Scores will be calculated as stated in SI 17.1.
  - d. B Overall - This trophy will be awarded to the B fleet boat that won the PHRF SoCal Championship Regatta. Scores will be calculated as stated in SI 17.1.
