“Llew” was a native Californian and a fifth generation resident of Santa Barbara County. His great-grandfather, Gene Rogers, was active in seal and otter hunting in the Channel Islands in the late 1800s. Llew and his wife Marilyn raised their four children in Carpinteria on historic property that had been in his family since 1948. He attended local public schools and graduated from Long Beach State in 1964 with a degree in Economics. He served three years on sea duty in the U.S. Marine Corps aboard the USS *Los Angeles*. He spent 30 years in commercial real estate managing and developing shopping centers in five western states. Llew was past president of the University Club of Santa Barbara and Santa Barbara Maritime Museum. He had two noteworthy accomplishments while commodore in 1996. He negotiated a trade with the city for the guest dock in Marina One, which was important for Yacht Club visitors sailing into the city. Llew organized and then served as project manager for the construction of the Yacht Club’s elevator.
