Potter

This Potter Cup is both the first and oldest trophy in the Santa Barbara Yacht Club collection. It was first presented by Milo Potter of the Potter Hotel to the Yacht Club for Class-A “35-foot yacht cruisers” for the 1907 South Coast Regatta. In 1961, it was rededicated as Season Trophy Ocean Racing Class-B. In 1965, it was rededicated as Season Trophy, MORF, and in 1972, it was rededicated as Wet Wednesday, PHRF-B

Doulton

Another one of the older trophies, the Doulton Trophy was donated in 1923 by the great grandson of the founder of Royal Doulton China. Harold Doulton owned the Miramar Hotel and donated a silver (not porcelain!) trophy for the 1923 Regatta. In 1997, this trophy was rededicated to Wet Wednesdays PHRF.
