

John Jack BUGAY

B - 1928 D - 2021

Santa Barbara Yacht Club member 1954 – 1975

Jack (as he was called) was a local attorney with an interest in banking. He started Presidio Savings & Loan in Santa Barbara, which ultimately was bought out by a larger banking company.

Jack also circumnavigated the globe in his Kettenburg, K-40, "*TIOGA*"

In the mid 1960's, when the Club was building its new clubhouse, Jack acted as the Club Attorney, reviewing all contractual contracts, procedural requirements, revamping the "Articles of Incorporation", and the issuance of the Bonds to fund the construction. In the SBYC History Book, p.-111, Jack was credited with "keeping the construction moving".

Jack and his wife Patty spent many years boating, Jack had four sailboats: the "*TEMPEST, TIOGA, TIOGA II* and the *SIBONAY*".

In 1962, Jack donated to the Club a trophy, to be perpetually awarded to the Yacht representing the SBYC that made the best showing in an ocean race of 1,000 miles or more. This trophy is a large canoe paddle from the South Pacific Islands.
