ATTACHMENT D – BIG AIR COMPETITION

- 1 The Big Air Competition will not count towards points for the KiteFoil US National Championship. It is an 'add-on' event that will take place for 20 minutes at the end of each race day.
- 2 There will be a 20 minute jump window. The jump window will begin shortly after the last finish on the last race of the day. The start of the jump window will be announced over megaphone. Competitors are allowed unlimited numbers of jumps within the jump window timeframe.
- 3 There will be a jump line through which each jumping kiter should pass and use as a jumping point. The jump line will be between a yellow tetrahedron and a white cylinder mark with a yellow band and the letter 'G' on it. There will be no false starts and every jump will count. The jump line is shown below.
- 4 The best jump for each competitor will be the only one that counts. No jump will count negatively against a competitor.
- 5 Competitors will be responsible for figuring out who's going next (similar to red-bull competitions). Signal to the Race Committee (RC) who's jumping next by raising your hand. Only one jumper at a time please. The RC will let the judges know who's jumping and they will score each jump for all three of the following criteria:
 - Height
 - Hang Time
 - Style & Tricks
- 6 At the end of each day, there will be daily Big Air Competition glasses given out. The amount of glasses given out will be decided based on the number of jumpers and what the judge committee decides.
