

Dick Reichel Trophy for CHRF / H Fleet

“Whereas it is the desire of the Santa Barbara Yacht Club to encourage participation of all Fleets in the Club's racing program; and whereas the Santa Barbara Yacht Club awards trophies which serve both to preserve each Fleet's historical record and to recognize each Fleet's annual champion racing skipper who wins the right to compete in the Santa Barbara Yacht Club's annual *Centennial Cup*; and whereas it is the desire of the Club Handicap Fleet Committee to establish a perpetual trophy for the Club Handicap Fleet's champion skipper who has compiled the best racing record in both the CHRF and the H Fleets in a given calendar year, therefore, it is with great pleasure that the Club Handicap Fleet Committee supports the desire of Al Reichel to establish such a perpetual trophy in memory of his brother Dick Reichel, longtime Santa Barbara Yacht Club member and avid sailboat racer. This trophy shall henceforth be known as The Santa Barbara Yacht Club's *Dick Reichel Perpetual Trophy*.”

At the end of the year, the identity of the winning CHRF/H Fleet Skipper who shall be awarded the Reichel Trophy shall be determined as follows:

The CHRF High Point Place shall be added to the Wet Wednesday Overall H-Fleet place. The total score for each boat will determine the Reichel Trophy winner on a low point basis. Non-SBYC club boats will be eliminated from the H-Fleet year end standings. Each SBYC H-Fleet boat will move up in the standings to fill the vacancy created by removing a non-SBYC boat. If there is a tie for the combined score, the boat with the lowest CHRF place will place higher in the Reichel Score.
